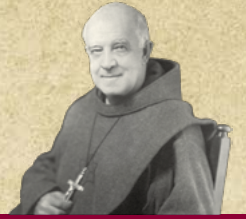

Friendship is a gift. Father Paul was a friend to many. One special friend was Father Solanus Casey who was Beatified on November 18, 2017. Father Paul met Father Solanus when he visited the Capuchins in Yonkers, N.Y. Meeting Father Solanus at the Yonker's Friary developed into a deep friendship.

On June 17, 1910, St. John's Church was dedicated and Father Paul celebrated his first Mass as a Roman Catholic priest. Father Solanus was the Deacon and preached the sermon. Father Solanus was at the dedication of St. Francis Chapel on January 18, 1912. Both men had a great deal in common.

They were men of prayer. Both made themselves available to people for various forms of ministry. I believe that they are good models of people who accept Jesus as The Lord and then show us how to express our faith in prayer and good works.

In the Communion of Saints, we are never alone.
